As a healthcare professional, you can call this line at any time to be connected to more than 200 local, trained resources across the state depending on your needs. Anything from immediate needs like mental or medical health, shelter, safe spaces, or transportation to longer term needs like substance abuse treatment, employment assistance, mentorship or leadership development programming.

## TRUSTED LOCAL PARTNERS

### **Legal Advocacy: Colorado Legal Services (CLS) (303) 837-1313**

CLS provides meaningful access to high quality, civil legal services in the pursuit of justice for as many low-income persons and members of vulnerable populations throughout Colorado. They have 14 locations across the state.

### **Rocky Mountain Immigrant Advocacy Network (RMIAN) (303) 433-2812**

RMIAN provides free immigration legal services to immigrant children and to adults in immigration detention.

### **Colorado Organization for Victim Assistance (COVA) (303) 861-1160**

COVA offers comprehensive case management for victims of human trafficking.

### **The Gathering Place (303) 321-4198**

The Gathering Place is the only daytime drop-in center in metropolitan Denver that serves women, their children, and transgender individuals who are experiencing poverty, many of whom are also experiencing homelessness.

### **The Harm Reduction Action Center (303) 572-7800**

The Harm Reduction Action Center has committed itself to serving Colorado's public health by working to reduce the harms associated with drug use. They provide direct services that curb the spread of HIV, Hepatitis C, and accidental overdoses among people who inject drugs.

### **El Centro Humanitario (303) 292-4115**

El Centro Humanitario Para Los Trabajadores provides educational opportunities and ensures safe working conditions for day laborers in Denver.

### **Street's Hope (303) 433-2712**

Street's Hope provides services to support and empower people who have experienced human trafficking. They provide case management and mental health services as well as group mentoring.

### **Colorado Coalition for the Homeless (303) 293-2217**

Colorado Coalition for the Homeless provides integrated housing, health care, vocational and supportive services, for individuals experiencing homelessness.

### **Asia Pacific Development Center (720) 394-7909**

Asia Pacific Development Center (APDC) focuses on a holistic approach to bringing compassionate care and culturally responsive services to the communities they serve. APDC acts as a "one-stop" shop for clients to get a variety of resources all in one building.
